Date: January 31, 2025

I conducted the January 2025 audit of the Flock System per East Palo Alto Police Department Policy 428. The audit is from January 1st through January 31st. The Flock system has been live since December 10, 2024. During this time our system has captured the license plates of 4,006,782 vehicles. In the January 2025 audit period our officers conducted 1,286 searches. All of these searches were made within policy with valid cases numbers or reasons for the search. All East Palo Alto searches conducted were made within in policy with a valid reason or case number.

As of today's date, we have 23 of the 25 cameras live. We have the 24th camera being installed next week, and still waiting Caltrans approval for the last camera.

East Palo Alto Flock cameras notable activity:

- 1) January 3, 2025 – Flock alerted on a stolen vehicle entering East Palo Alto. Officers located the vehicle and arrested the driver.
- 2) January 3, 2025 – Flock alerted on a vehicle entering East Palo Alto wanted for several armed robberies in Oakland. Officers located the vehicle and attempted to conduct an enforcement stop. The vehicle failed to yield and was lost.
- 3) January 3, 2025 – Flock assisted in a robbery case in East Palo Alto. The above vehicle committed a robbery prior to the police locating the vehicle.
- 4) January 4, 2025 – Flock assisted East Palo Alto Officers with locating a license plate on an assault.
- 5) January 7, 2025 – Flock assisted East Palo Alto Officers in locating a vehicle used in a theft at Nordstrom's rack.
- 6) *January 8, 2025 – Flock located a stolen vehicle at Bell and University. East Palo Alto Officers located the vehicle, which fled at a high rate of speed. The driver abandoned the vehicle and was not located. The vehicle was recovered and returned to the owner.*
- 7) *January 14, 2025 – Flock alerted on a wanted vehicle entering East Palo Alto from the San Jose Police Department. Menlo Park Police located and recovered the vehicle.*

- 8) *January 16, 2025 – Flock assisted in locating a suspect vehicle for a hit and run. East Palo Alto Officers entered the vehicle into the Flock system to be alerted when it returns.*
- 9) *January 19, 2025 – Flock assisted in a felony hit and run that lead to a DUI investigation/ arrest.*
- 10) *January 21, 2025 – Flock assisted in locating a hit and run vehicle. The driver was located and arrested.*
- 11) *January 21, 2025 – Flock assisted in locating a hit and run vehicle. Case pending follow-up.*
- 12) *January 22, 2025 – Flock alerted on a wanted felony vehicle out of Newark Police. East Palo Alto Officers located the vehicle and detained the occupants. Newark impounded the vehicle.*
- 13) *January 23, 2025 – Flock alerted East Palo Alto Officers on a vehicle that had fled from officers prior this week.*
- 14) *January 23, 2025 – Flock alerted East Palo Alto Officers of a stolen vehicle in town. A be on the lookout was given to Menlo Park Police with the vehicle information. A Menlo Park Officer located the stolen vehicle and arrested the occupant.*
- 15) *January 25, 2025 – Flock alerted East Palo Alto Officers of as stolen vehicle. The vehicle was located unoccupied and returned to the owner.*
- 16) *January 26, 2025 – Flock alerted East Palo Alto Officers of as stolen vehicle. The vehicle was located unoccupied and returned to the owner.*
- 17) *January 27, 2025 – Flock assisted East Palo Alto Officers in locating a hit and run suspect vehicle. Officers located the suspect vehicle and contacted the driver. The driver admitted to the crime.*
- 18) *January 30, 2025 – Flock alerted East Palo Alto Officers of a stolen vehicle that entered town in the early hours. Patrol vehicle the surrounding area and located the stolen vehicle unoccupied. The vehicle was returned to the owner.*
